




UNICEF'S RESPONSE IN 2019

The Highlights²⁶

- Over 3.3 MILLION CHILDREN were vaccinated against polio in Syria.
- Nearly 750,000 CHILDREN received routine immunization or vaccination against measles in Syria and neighbouring countries.
- Over 1 MILLION CHILDREN reached with psychosocial support in Syria and in neighbouring countries.
- Nearly 3 MILLION CHILDREN had access to formal and non-formal education in Syria and neighbouring countries.
- In Syria, Jordan, Lebanon and Iraq, over 5.3 MILLION PEOPLE had safe water through improvements to water supply systems.
- Nearly 2 million people received water, sanitation and hygiene facilities and sanitation services in Syria and neighbouring countries

To date, UNICEF received only 40 per cent of its total funding requirements for 2020.

To continue responding to the needs of children and their families inside Syria and in neighbouring countries, UNICEF urgently needs **US \$682 MILLION.**

A displaced mother with her child in Aleppo.

Born with jaundice to a malnourished mother, Janna, did not have the best start in life. She was put in an incubator upon birth and her mother did not breastfeed her. After visiting the UNICEF supported clinic in the Hanano neighborhood of Aleppo she was provided with therapeutic nutritional supplements and was put on a treatment plan.
