
























UNICEF Netherlands works to ensure you get all the rights in the UNCRC.




120 countries have agreed to the UNCRC.

The UNCRC contains 21 rights which are called articles.






Casus





We cannot hang out there anymore, but we have nowhere else to go.














I am Steven and I am 15. Yesterday night I was playing loud music on the bus through the speaker on my phone.








I am Barbara and I am 17. Some time ago I was


placed under surveillance by youth care in a




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Story cards Respecting rights




I like all the teachers at my school and I think they are good teachers. We have more or less the same amount of Dutch and Caribbean teachers. I like this mix very much!




